Businessmen from Kurdistan visit Lebanon:

A project to eliminate unemployment:

The Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs recently announced the start of a project that is supported by the government, in coordination with the United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS). The project aims to eliminate unemployment and poverty that affect Iraqis in the Al – Basra governorate. The project will start in June, once the Strategic Commission in the Ministry of Planning will be granting approvals. The project will help in creating jobs by establishing four Funds: one to support microfinance projects, one to support infrastructure and public services, one in support to farmers and a social protection Fund. The project cost more than \$4 million.
